Application Period

15.05.-15.06.2021 for the following winter semester

Applications are only accepted within the application period. The date of receipt of the complete application documents is decisive, not the postmark. If the last day of the application period is a Saturday, Sunday or public holiday, the application documents can still be submitted on the following working day.

However, the application for admission to the study program is only activated until the last day of the deadline.

It is recommended that you apply as early as possible within the application period, so that you can clarify any questions that may arise in good time with our StudyGuide:

Subject to the approval of the appropriate Senate office, valid are the versions of the admission regulations published in the official gazette ("Mitteilungsblatt") of the TU Berlin and in the "UdK Anzeiger".

Entrance requirements

- a first professional university degree in a course of study in the fields of arts and design, humanities, education, social sciences, economics, law, natural sciences, engineering, mathematics, computer science, medicine
- artistic talent

- for international applicants: sufficient knowledge of German (details see below)

Application and submission of application documents

Please register first in the online portal within the application period:

Then you can create and submit an application for admission. Once you have successfully completed the online application, print out the application for admission, sign it and send it, also within the application period, by regular mail to the UdK Berlin together with the following documents:

- Printout of the online application form (signed)
- Detailed CV in tabular form (with a brief explanation of the desired course of study)
- Bank statement (for transfers from abroad, proof of payment) documenting payment of €30 application fee. Other proofs/receipts (such as transfer orders) will not be accepted! This fee can't be refunded even if applicants withdraw from the application process.

- Proof of the first university degree (university degree certificates)
- In case the certificate does not state the exact number of CP gained throughout the studies please attach a relevant statement from the school/university.
- Applicants who have not yet completed their Bachelor's degree at the time of application should submit a current transcript of records. The university degree must then be available for enrolment at the latest.
- Foreign university degrees must be recognized by uni-assist before the application at UdK Berlin. The uni-assist certificate ("Vorprüfungsdokumentation/VPD") has to be submitted together with the complete application documents. Detailed information can be found here:

- Applicants from the People's Republic of China, Vietnam and Mongolia have to contact the Academic Evaluation Center (APS) at the German embassy for the recognition of their certificates and the visa procedure. Please do not turn to uni-assist! Detailed information and the forms can be found on the respective APS homepage

- Proof of knowledge of German (international applicants):

At the time of application: proof of linguistic ability equivalent to level B1

At the time of matriculation: proof of linguistic ability equivalent to level C1. Please find an overview of the accepted language proofs on our website:

Foreigners with a German school leaving certificate or a university degree should submit their certificate. A separate proof of language skills is not required.

- **Work/ samples of work (portfolio) that can be presented in a variety of media, for example, texts, artistic design portfolio, audio, film, etc.**

The work/samples of work should demonstrate your individual approach, content interests, and skills in the context of our cross-university, interdisciplinary, research-oriented master's program Design & Computation.

The work/samples of work and a copy of the formal documents will be uploaded on the "Bemus" platform in parallel with the application deadline.

Admissions procedure

The admission procedure consists of the pre-selection and the entrance examination. The pre-selection is based on the submitted work samples. The admission examination then follows for the selected applicants*.

The invitation to the entrance examination will be sent by e-mail.

The admission examination are planned to take place in presence in the week of 19-25.07.2021. If necessary, exceptions to the admission procedure can also be examined due to Corona protection measures, e.g. due to travel restrictions, it is possible to apply to carry out the entrance examination digitally.
